

School-Based Prevention

Team of Concern (TOC)

A community and school based program that provides student, teachers, parents, and families with preventive education and information that increases a person's abilities to avoid risk taking behaviors which could lead to alcohol and other drug use.

Services Available:

- Classroom Presentations
- Small Group Education
 - Topics include alcohol and other drug education, social skills, healthy relationships, peer pressure, emotion regulation, communication, self esteem, etc
- 1x1 Interventions with students
- Referral Facilitation to other services
- Community awareness booths at school events

Early Intervention Services:

1x1 intervention for students who:

- Has never used drugs, but is at risk
- Has family members who use drugs or are addicted to alcohol or other drugs
- Has trouble in school or skips classes
- Has had exposure to a traumatic event
- Regularly socializes with friends that use drugs
- May have easy access to drugs in their neighborhood.
- Has trouble making friends or is being bullied
- Lives in a neighborhood with guns and/or gangs
